Canada 150 Stamp Quilt

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Simplifying images to their core elements makes for a crisp, clean design and the Canada 150 Stamp quilt is no exception. The strong graphic of the deckled stamp edge is created with the addition of fused black half circles – simply brilliant! Create this commemorative project as a selfie photo station backdrop. Capture family photos at your 2017 events or family reunions.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 45" x 54"

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

This quilt is made with Michael Miller's Cotton Couture fabrics. The following is a list of the colours used:

- Orange (orange)
- Cornflower (blue)
- Pink (light pink)
- Raspberry (dark pink)
- Magenta (purple)
- Lime (green)
- Cherry (red)



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MATERIALS:

- ¼ m of 6 solid fabrics for nine patch blocks: orange, blue, light pink, dark pink, purple, green
- 2 m White for centre panel and block construction
- ½ m Red for inner border and corner leaf blocks
- ½ m Black for lettering and binding
- 2 m Fabric for backing and hanging sleeve
- Batting (approximately 48 x 60")
- Fusible - for applique letters and half circles
- 11 Circles; (Back fabric with fusible of choice. Use a can or glass approximately 3 – 3.5" in diameter to mark and cut circles and then divide in half for a total of 22 half circles)

PATTERN IS COMPOSED OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 14 Modified 9 patch blocks @ 9" square
- 4 Leaf corner blocks @ 9" square
- 1" Inner border (cut at 1 ½" wide)
- Centre panel 25 ½ x 34 ½"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

RED:

- 4 Strips at 1 ½" for inner border, trimmed to 2 at 25 ½"; 2 at 36 ½"
- 12 Squares at 3 ½ x 3 ½"
- 8 Squares at 4 x 4" to create hsts
- 4 Strips 1 x 6" for leaf stems

PURPLE, PINK, DARK PINK, BLUE, GREEN, ORANGE;

Cut from each colour:

- 14 squares at 3 ½" x 3 ½"

WHITE:

- 1 Square 25 ½ x 34 ½
- 14 Rectangles at 3 ½ x 9 ½"
- 12 Squares at 4" to create hsts and leaf stem squares
- 4 Squares at 3 ½"

BLACK:

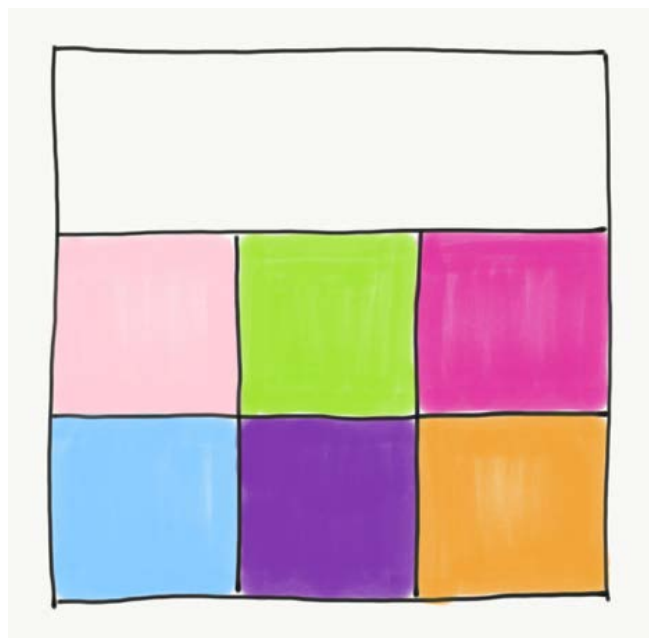
- 5 Strips wof at 2 ½" for binding
- Letters C A N A D A and numbers 1 5 0

- 11 Circles; (Black fabric backed with fusible webbing of choice. Use a can or glass approximately 3 to 3.5" in diameter to mark and cut circles and then divide each circle in half for a total of 22 half circles)

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Modified nine patch; Using one white 3 ½ x 9 ½" rectangle and the 6 colours in 3 ½" squares, sew block together as shown in illustration below

Make 14 nine patch blocks



Leaf block; You will need the following to create each leaf block

- 4 hst at 3 ½" in red and white
- 3 squares at 3 ½" red
- 1 square at 3 ½" white
- 1 square at 4" white... into which we will insert the red leaf stem
- 1 Strip 1 x 6" red (stem)

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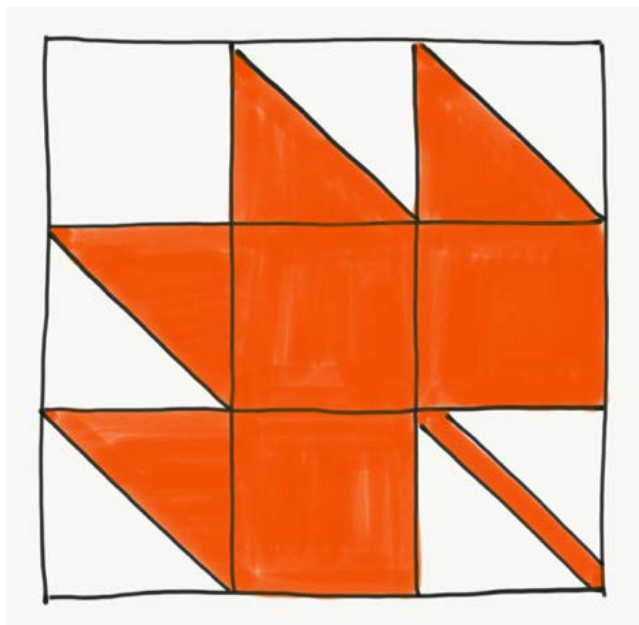
Let's get the stem out of the way first...

- Cut your 4" white square in half diagonally
- Sew your red strip (1 x 6") onto one half of the white
- Press
- Sew your white triangle to the other side of the red strip
- Press
- Trim to 3 1/2" square

Create your hsts using your preferred method

Assemble block as shown in illustration below

Make 4 leaf blocks



QUILT TOP CONSTRUCTION:

- 1 Sew red inner border to white centre panel; start with top and bottom then add sides
- 2 Sew top and bottom pieced borders to centre; start with top and bottom borders (3 modified nine patch blocks wide)
- 3 Sew side border to quilt top (4 modified nine patch blocks and one red leaf block at each end)
- 4 Fuse half square circles to quilt top using photo as your guide
- 5 Fuse appliqué letters again using the picture as your guide... remember to trace the letters and numbers in reverse onto the paper of your fusible
- 6 Quilt
- 7 Bind and add hanging sleeve

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
